

# Hot Potato Game

**Can you name Irish grown fruit and vegetables?**

## **What you will need:**

A group of people (maybe other pupils in your class)

Some music that can be played and stopped by a teacher/adult

A ball or beanbag to pass around

## **How to play:**

1. Everyone should sit in a circle (you can also do this at your desks).
2. One pupil begins by passing the ball or beanbag to the pupil sitting next to them. Music should be playing in the background.
3. When the music stops, the person holding the 'hot potato' must name a fruit or vegetable that grows in Ireland. If a pupil cannot think of an answer, they are out of the game.
4. The last person is the winner.
